Fujita Corporation's response to the disaster

Out of a collective sense of responsibility felt by the Construction Industry, we began reconstructing public infrastructures and private buildings immediately after the quake.

11 March 2011: Creation of task forces to take immediate disaster countermeasures (Headquarter and Tohoku-Branch)

13 March 2011: Transport of the first emergency supplies for the Tohoku-District 14 March 2011: 14 corporate members dispatched as support staff for Tohoku-District

By 21 March 2011: 14 deliveries of supplies, total of 30 corporate members dispatched

Now, we are conducting many projects, for example the disposal of disaster-related waste, the decontamination of radioactive substances, and salt removal from agricultural land.
